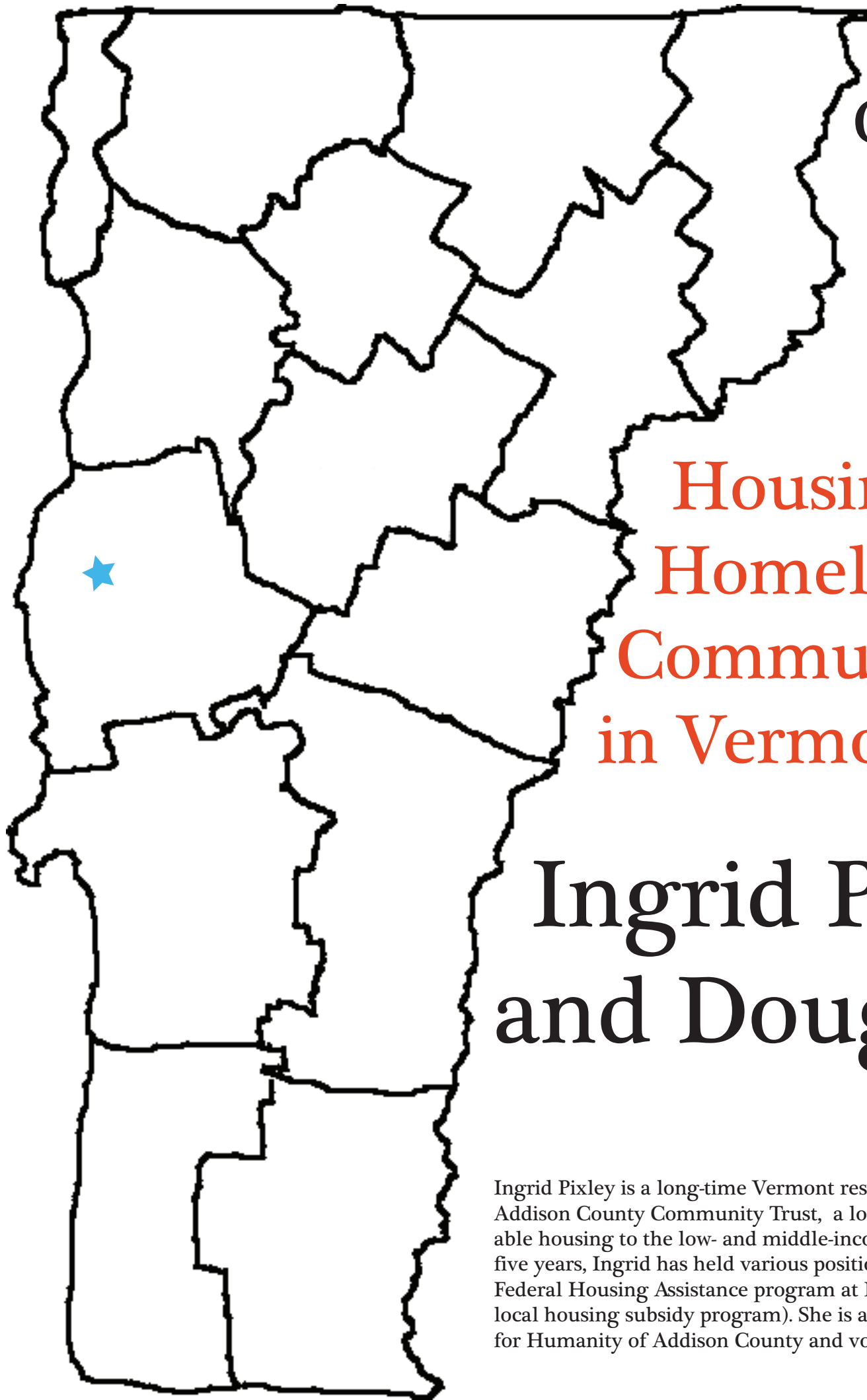

Housing Issues, Homelessness and Community Action in Vermont

Ingrid Pixley and Doug Sinclair

Ingrid Pixley is a long-time Vermont resident, working as a Property Manager for Addison County Community Trust, a local non-profit organization that provides affordable housing to the low- and middle-income people of Addison County. Over the past five years, Ingrid has held various positions with the State of Vermont, administered a Federal Housing Assistance program at HOPE, is a co-founder of Housing Solutions (a local housing subsidy program). She is a board member of MCCC, CSAC and Habitat for Humanity of Addison County and volunteers for the Community at Charter House.

Doug Sinclair's the co-founder of the Middlebury Community Care Coalition (MCCC), which since 2004 has since grown to 600 members who contribute over 18,000 volunteer hours per year supporting the housing and food needs of families and individuals who need a helping hand. Doug also teaches in Vermont State Colleges including Castleton State College and Community College of Vermont, and runs a tree farm. His community work has made Doug a recipient of the Bonnie and John McCardell Citizen's Award, Governor's Award for Outstanding Community Service, and Vermont Campus Compact Engaged Community Partner Award.
